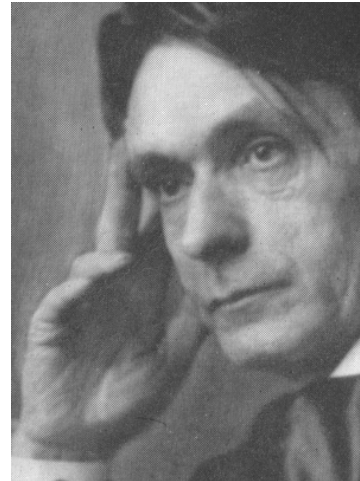


Rudolf Steiner
